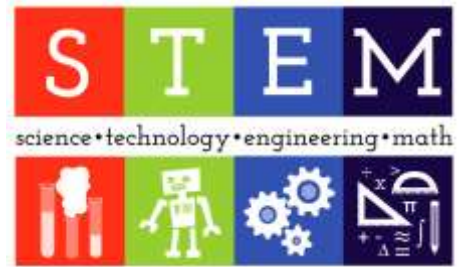

GCSE Exam Support

Before the exam period there is supervised quiet study provision available for all students in the library and Year 11 in S1 Monday to Thursday. As well as this, there are individual and group sessions after school or at lunchtime, arranged by departments and individual class teachers.

Duke of Edinburgh Award (DofE)

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is a voluntary, non-competitive programme giving our young people the opportunity to experience new activities or develop existing skills. At Framingham Earl, we offer our Year 9/10 students the chance to complete their Bronze Level Award, completing a programme of activities in four sections; Volunteering, Physical, Skills and Expedition. On average, between 28 and 35 students sign up in Year 9, when the programme begins.

In Year 9, students enrol and begin their activities in Skills, Volunteering and/or Physical with further training and a Practice Expedition taking place during Activities Week.

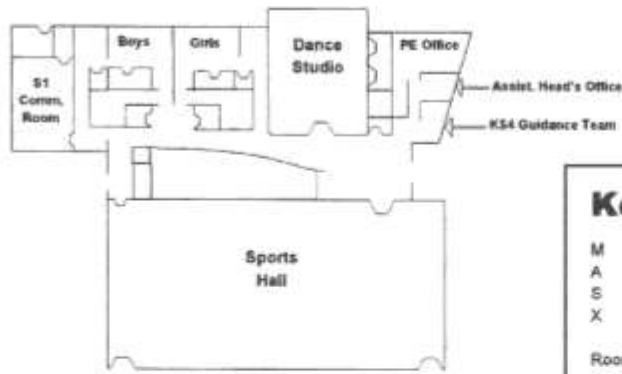
