

Annual Activity Survey for Framingham Earl High School

Welcome to Children's Services' 2020 annual Activity Survey. It provides information about the first destinations of young people reaching the statutory school leaving age in the summer of 2020. With over 8000 young people to follow up each year it takes the dedication of a number of key people to make the survey possible. I would like to thank staff at schools, colleges and sixth forms along with Norfolk County Council's Guidance Advisers, Young Persons' Advisers, Keeping in Touch Team and staff from the Participation, Transition & Strategy Team. It is worth noting that all young people are expected to continue in education or training (in learning) until at least 18 years of age. Therefore the 'in-learning' figures are a particularly important focus of this report.

There is a higher than usual number of Unknown activities amongst this years cohort which may go some way towards explaining the drop in the In Learning Percentage.

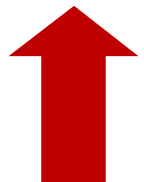

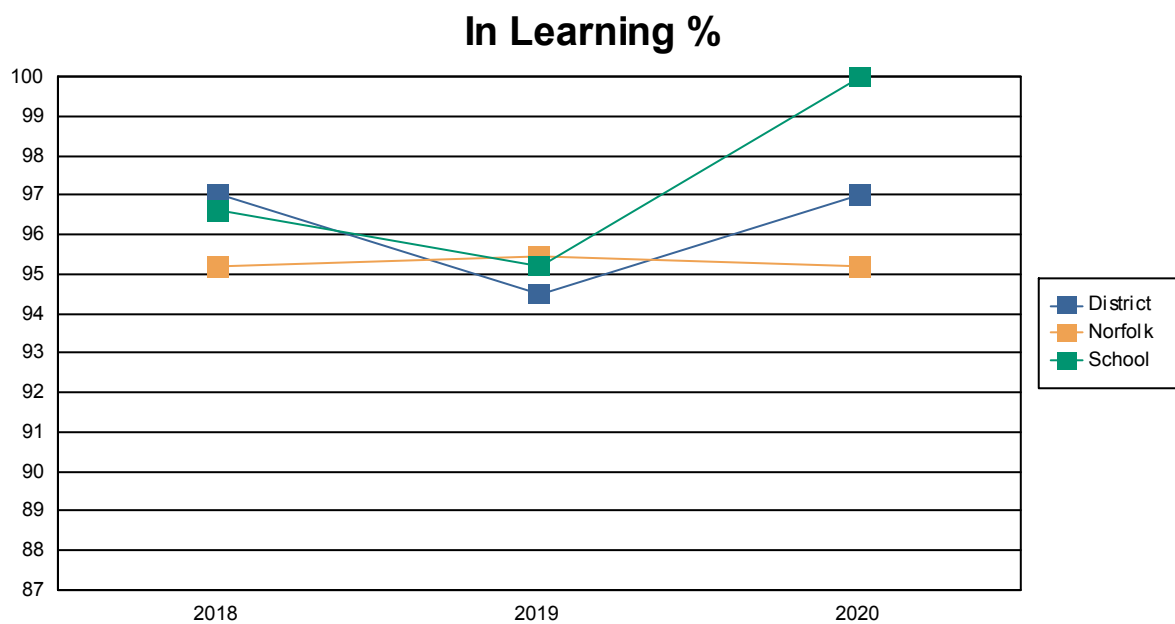

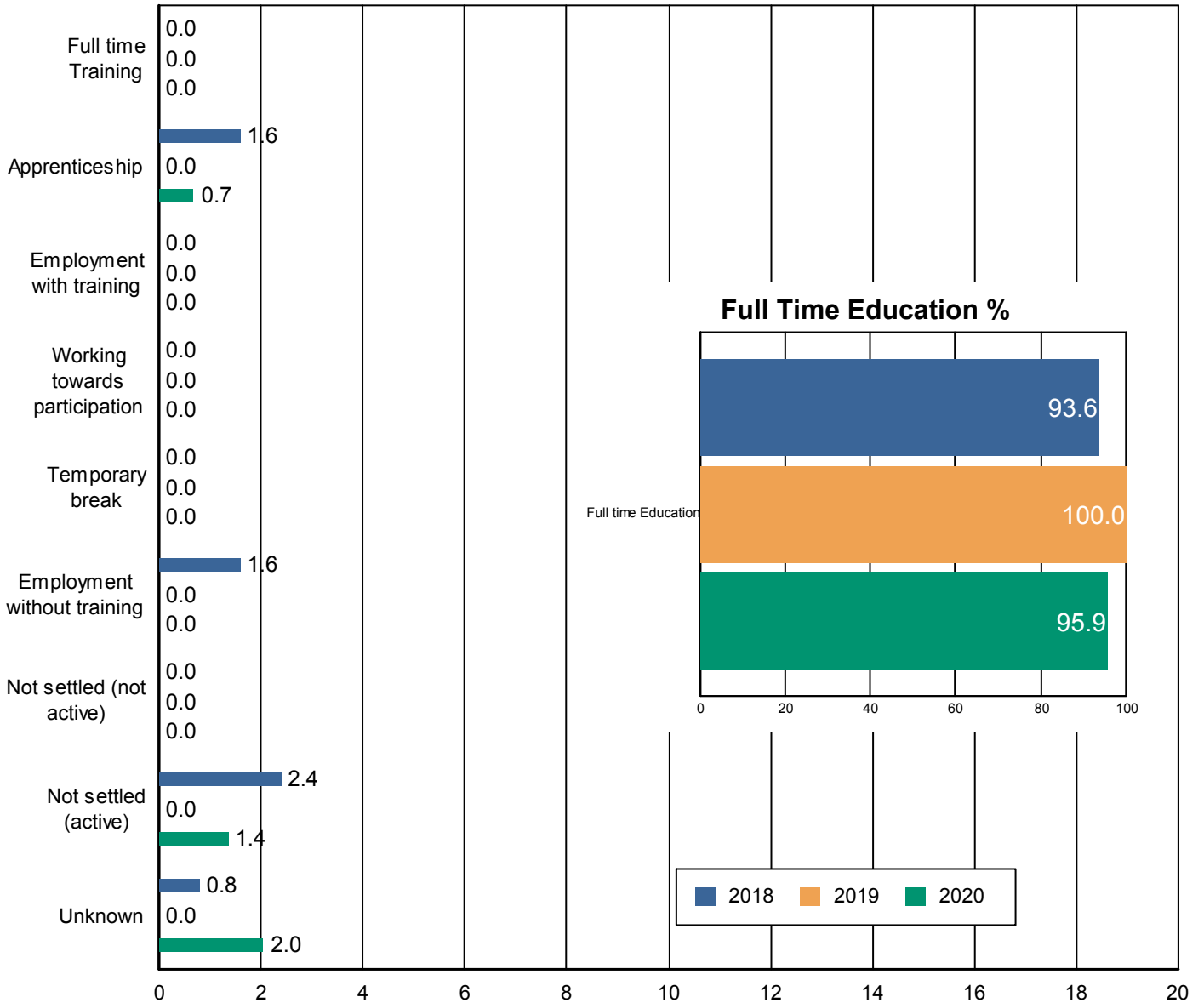
