Dear Parents and Carers

Several of our families are currently benefiting from the Government Pupil Premium 'Free School Meals' initiative. In addition to children receiving money each day on their Vericol account to spend in the school canteen, the school also receives money (pupil premium funding) to support with learning resources.

We are very keen that all those families who are eligible sign up for the scheme. Even if your child does not plan to use this money in the canteen, the school still receives the additional pupil premium funding that can be used to support resources and opportunities, such as trips and music lessons.

If your circumstances have changed recently, you may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

In order to support schools with this initiative this year and to encourage early registration, the local authority will fund for the family of every **newly eligible** child that registers before the end of the Summer term 2021 a meal voucher to the value of £10 per eligible child.

Rather than waiting until September, if you think you are eligible you can apply online now: <https://www.norfolk.gov.uk/education-and-learning/schools/school-meals-and-milk>. Please can you apply no later than **Friday 9th July** in order to qualify for the additional voucher and to ensure your funds are ready in September.
