Summary Points:

Secondary schools should offer pupils testing at an on-site ATS from 8 March. Testing and return of pupils can be phased during the first week to manage the number of pupils passing through the test site at any one time. You should offer 3 tests, 3 to 5 days apart.

Testing is voluntary. If consent is provided, pupils will be asked to self-swab at the on-site ATS and after 30 minutes they should be informed of their results.

Individuals with a positive LFD test result will need to self-isolate in line with the guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection. Those with a negative LFD test result can continue to attend school unless they have individually been advised otherwise by NHS Test and Trace or Public Health professionals (for example as a close contact). They should continue to apply the measures in the system of controls to themselves and the wider school setting.

[After the initial 3 tests] Both pupils and staff in secondary schools will be supplied with LFD test kits to self-swab and test themselves twice a week at home. Staff and pupils must report their result to NHS Test and Trace as soon as the test is completed either online or by telephone as per the instructions in the home test kit.

Staff and pupils should also share their result, whether void, positive or negative, with their school to help with contact tracing.

Adolescents aged 12 to 17 should self-test and report with adult supervision. The adult may conduct the test if necessary. Children aged 11 attending a secondary school should be tested by an adult.

Staff or pupils with a positive LFD test result will need to self-isolate in line with the stay-at-home guidance. They will also need to arrange a lab-based polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test to confirm the result if the test was done at home. Those with a negative LFD test result can continue to attend school and use protective measures.

Plan for FEHS:

On the Lateral Flow Test day there will be no live lessons for this year group (for example Wednesday 10th March Y8 will have no live lessons). Students will complete any assignments on Teams and prepare equipment/resources for face-to-face lessons.

Additional Safety Measures in place:

Engagement with NHS Track and Trace and Government guidelines regarding isolation	As per the Home School Agreement we will continue to request all families to follow the rulings regarding self-isolation if there are COVID symptoms or if they have been close contacts to a positive case
One-way systems and Entry/Exit only doors	These will remain in buildings as per pre-Christmas
Hand sanitising	The requirement for children to sanitise their hands as they enter a room remains
Mobile Phones	These remain prohibited during school time unless when directed to use by a teacher or a specific request is made to a teacher to contact a parent/carer
Wearing of face coverings in classrooms and corridors	This will remain in place until Easter when the Government reviews (plain coverings and not neck buffs please). Any child with an exemption is expected to wear the badge provided by Mrs Harvey.
Bubbles	Year group bubbles will remain for social times and students on buses are requested to continue to sit in year group blocks
Food pre-ordering	Lunches and snacks will be available to pre order as before to avoid lengthy queuing at service points
Food outlet points	These will be allocated to year groups linked to social spaces (we have one additional outlet point on the playground)
Lockers	These will not be returning to action as they continue to present an issue creating 'pinch points'
Equipment sharing/loaning	Students are required to bring their own equipment to school (pens, pencils, calculator etc.) to avoid sharing of objects
Cleaning and Fogging	Touch point cleaning to continue throughout the school day and fogging in rooms such as PE changing rooms after each use
Logging in school regular LFT completed at home	All students are required to log tests with the NHS Track and Trace service and with the school system
Enhanced in school risk assessment	Risk assessment in place and assessed by SET Health & Safety lead
Behaviour Policy Amendments	These remain in place as per September with a focus on pupil behaviour being compliant to hands-face-space guidance

Process for LFT when students are in school:

Students will follow the same process within the test centre as outlined above. However, groups will be brought by surname to the test centre and will log their test when they return home. If a result is positive students will be collected by a key adult and kept in an isolation area whilst awaiting collection by a parent. A PCR test will be given to the student to complete at home.

Process for LFT at home:

On Friday 19th March, each student will be issued with a pack of home tests. These will be completed twice per week and results logged on the NHS Track and Trace as well as a central school form. Each pack contains 7 tests. Any child with symptoms must not come to school and should book a PCR test. If you have been a close contact, you must isolate as per Track and Trace guidance.
